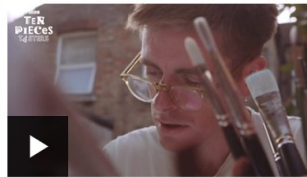
CREATE

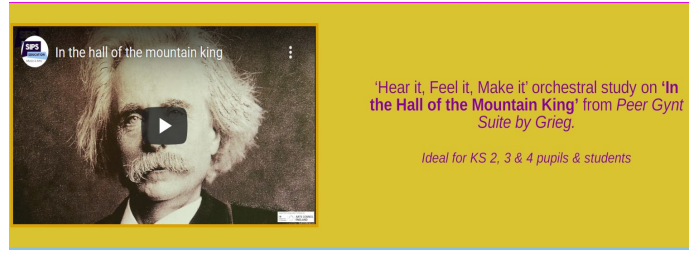
