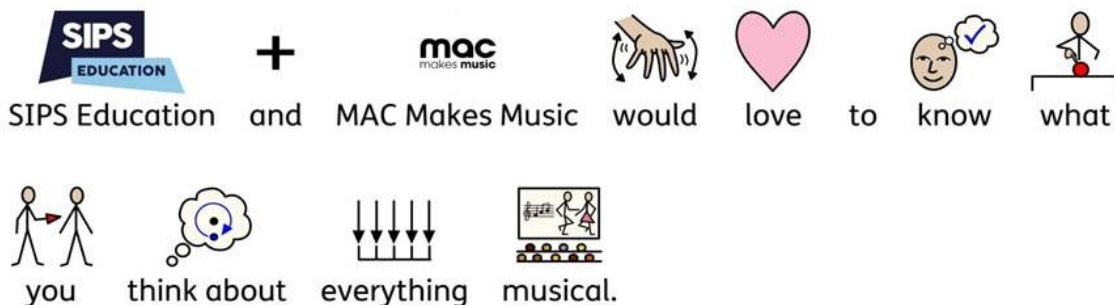

Singing supports learning, personal and social development, promotes health and well-being.

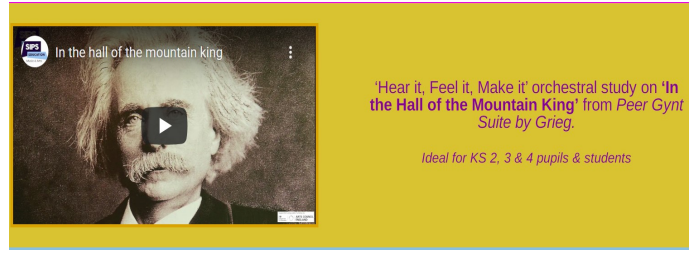
